Nuffield Department of Medicine Graduate Studies Committee

Terms of Reference

Preamble

The Nuffield Department of Medicine Graduate Studies Committee (GSC) meets termly to discuss policy on admissions and the provision for current graduates and supervisors in the department. The Committee reports to the Head of Department.

1. Terms of Reference

The GSC shall be responsible for:

- a) overseeing admissions and the awarding of NDM prize studentships and NDM prizes;
- b) operational management of graduate student processes and policies;
- c) providing oversight of graduate courses within NDM;
- d) providing oversight of the summer internship programme;
- e) reviewing and responding to student feedback;
- f) receiving communications and providing feedback to the NDM Student Committee;
- g) discussing and agreeing the roles of Graduate Advisors (Assistant DGSs);
- h) providing oversight of supervisors and ensuring that they receive appropriate training and are following University and Departmental guidelines/policies;
- i) ensuring that all aspects of work carried out by the committee follow University Policies including the Regulations for Committees: http://www.admin.ox.ac.uk/statutes/regulations/519-122.shtml

2. Membership

The GSC shall consist of:

- a) the Director of Graduate Studies, who shall be chair of the committee;
- b) the Deputy Director of Graduate Studies;
- c) Graduate Advisors from each Unit;
- d) the Associate Head of Department (Academic, Support & Finance);
- e) the Graduate Studies Manager;
- f) two student representatives.
- 2.1 The committee may co-opt additional members for such periods as the committee shall deem appropriate
- 2.2 Other administrative officers or staff may attend from time to time, as appropriate.
- 2.3 Appointed, elected, and co-opted members of GSC, other than student members shall serve for a minimum of one year and membership will be renewed annually. Student members shall serve for a minimum of one year.

- 2.4 In reviewing its membership at its first meeting of the year, the GSC should consider whether to use its power of co-option to provide for a more diverse membership.
- 2.5 The current membership is detailed in Annexe A

3. Arrangements for meetings

- 3.1 The GSC will meet termly on Monday of 0th week at 11am 1pm (unless otherwise advised). The current schedule is detailed in Annexe B
- 3.2 Members of the GSC will be asked to declare any interest that could give rise to conflict in relation to any item on the agenda at the beginning of the item in question. All interests so disclosed will be recorded in the minutes. If the Chair deems it appropriate, the member shall absent himself or herself from all or part of the committee's discussion of the matter. Wording reflecting these provisions will be included at the beginning of every GSC agenda.
- 3.3 For the GSC, a quorum is 60% of those members eligible to vote upon the business of the committee.
